

# Noxious Weeds Classifications

<b>Class</b>	<b>Class Title</b>	<b>Prescribed Control Measures</b>
1	State Prohibited Weeds	Prevent establishment in New South Wales(district). Eradicate from the land and keep the land free of the plant. A person must comply with requirements in the Act for a
2	Regionally Prohibited Weeds	Prevent establishment in the region (district). Eradicate from the land and keep the land free of the weed. A person must comply with requirements in the Act for a notifiable weed.
3	Regionally Controlled Weeds	Reduce the area and impact of the plant (district). The plant must be fully and continuously suppressed and destroyed.
4	Locally Controlled Weeds	Minimise the negative impact of the weed on the economy, community or environment (district). The growth and spread of the weed must be controlled to the extent specified by the Local control authority.
5	Restricted Plants	Prevent introduction into New South Wales, the spread of the plant within New South Wales or from New South Wales to another jurisdiction (district). A person must comply with requirements in the Act for a notifiable weed. The requirements for s15 do not apply to serrated tussock, blackberry, Chilean needle grass, lantana, bitou bush, boneseed, willow, gorse.
